Dato' Sri Mustapa Mohamed will officiate PEMUDAH 15th Anniversary Forum on 7 February 2022

4 February 2022, Petaling Jaya – PEMUDAH or The Special Taskforce to Facilitate Business will celebrate its 15th anniversary of establishment on 7 February 2022. Dato' Sri Mustapa bin Mohamed, Minister in the Prime Minister's Department (Economy), who is also the Co-Chair of PEMUDAH, is expected to officiate PEMUDAH Forum in conjunction with the celebration.

The forum themed "Past lessons, future excellence, and productivity breakthrough" aptly captures PEMUDAH's 15-year journey. PEMUDAH started on 7 February 2007 as a public-private partnership body to enhance the business regulatory ecosystem by reducing unnecessary regulatory burdens on businesses. Sayed Munawar Sayed Mustar will moderate the Forum, which will deliberate on the theme.
